

Erath Matching Viticulture Scholarship

Attention – Winery/Vineyard Owners/Employers and Employees

The Chemeketa Community College Erath Matching Viticulture Scholarship is available for employees of Oregon winery/vineyards. The Erath Family Foundation (EFF) established this scholarship to increase the number of personnel in leadership roles who have a fundamental education in viticulture along with a working command of the English language.

Through a generous donation by EFF, wineries can support and encourage their employees to attend Chemeketa Community College and receive up to \$2,000 per academic year in matching funds.

How does the scholarship work?

1. Winery/Vineyard Owner/Employer may choose one or more employees they will fund to attend Chemeketa (up to \$2,000 per academic year).
2. The scholarship will match up to \$2,000 per academic year for the employee/student that is funded by the employer.
3. Scholarship funds are payable to the student/employee account upon receipt of the employer's sponsorship portion.
4. Employers may pay the full \$2,000 sponsorship payment at the beginning of the academic year to be spread out over the terms indicated by this application, or may pay per term if enrollment may fluctuate. All funds go toward tuition, books, and other educational costs. Overpayments will not be matched or carried over to another academic year.
5. **Checks should be payable to Chemeketa Community College**, not the Foundation.
6. Employee/Students must enroll in one of the following programs –
 - a. Vineyard Operations Certificate
 - b. Vineyard Management Degree
 - c. Winemaking Degree
 - d. ESOL/ENL

When do I need to apply?

Deadlines for application: Prior to the start of each term funds will be used
