Job Roles / Responsibilities

- Cleaning and sanitizing of both equipment and facility
- Forklifting - unloading and loading fruit, safely driving barrels – Forklift experience preferred.
- Harvest activities - moving, sorting, crushing, pressing, punching, and pumping all the grapes
- Additions - yeast, acid, nutrients, etc.
- Barrel work - cleaning, steaming, filling, emptying, and topping
- Tank work - racking, transferring/blending both juice and wine
- Sampling - obtain grape, juice, and/or wine samples

Requirements

Must be able to work in a fast-paced team environment. Work a fair amount of time spent outdoors in all weather conditions. Previous harvest and/or production experience is a plus but not required.

Requires work schedule flexibility.

Candidate should have effective English communication skills, both verbal and written.

The successful applicant must provide their own transportation.

All applicants must be able to legally work in the US.

Physical Demands

Position requires continuous walking, climbing, kneeling, crouching, and crawling throughout the shift for cleaning, sanitizing and sterilizing all winery equipment and facilities. lift up to 50 pounds for racking and pumping of juice and wine; moving hoses and equipment and to operate crush pad equipment.
